WHAT POSITIONS ARE THERE?

The LSA is proposing constitutional changes at its next Annual General Meeting (AGM) which will change the structure of the LSA. Therefore, the elections will be for the new roles under the constitution, assuming the changes pass at the AGM. If the changes do not pass, each of the elected roles will be fit within the equivalent role of the current Constitution.

The following pods are allowed:

The **Executive Pod** consisting of:

- Vice-President (Education);
- Vice-President (Finance and Events) and,
- Vice-President (Careers).

The **Finance and Events Pod** consisting of:

- Social Director;
- Marketing Director and,
- Communications Director.
OR
- Vice-President (Finance and Events);
- Social Director;
- Marketing Director and,
- Communications Director.

The **Education Pod** consisting of:

- Academic Affairs Director;
- Equity Director and,
- First Year Director.
OR
- Vice-President (Education);
- Academic Affairs Director;
- Equity Director and,
- First Year Director.

The **Careers Pod** consisting of:

- Sponsorship Director;
- Competitions Director and,
- Publications Director.
OR
- Vice-President (Careers);
- Sponsorship Director;
- Competitions Director and,
- Publications Director.

All roles can receive independent nominations, or nominations as a whole pod. No candidate can be part of two pods. For the avoidance of doubt, a Vice President Candidate cannot be part of both an Executive Pod and their respective pods.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1) Consider if you want to run in a pod or as an independent.
- 2) Email the current Committee Member and organise a meeting/have a discussion over message/email about the role and responsibilities.
- 3) Submit a nomination between Monday 25 May and Tuesday 2 June at 5PM.
- 4) Attend Candidates Briefing, to be held Wednesday 3 June (Week 2) 12PM or let the Electoral Sub-Committee (Current President) know if you can't attend.
- 5) Campaign online from Friday 5 June 5pm – Wednesday 10 June 12am and attend the virtual Candidates' Debate (Sunday 7 June 7pm)
- 6) Wait to hear at the Committee Announcement on Friday 12 June
